

## 2012 Golden Light Award

The Golden Light Award honors an *individual* who has made specific, meritorious contributions to society through his or her profession, community or field of voluntary service as lifetime achievements.

### Submission Guidelines

- Any person affiliated with an OGR member firm is eligible for the Golden Light Award, including owners, managers, and staff; self-nominations are also accepted.
- Answer the questions on the entry form, reflecting the nominee's lifetime achievements or service to OGR as a committee member, Regional Chairperson and/or Board member; community service activities; contributions to the funeral profession; development of programs within OGR or the funeral profession and community that exemplify "Service measured not by gold, but by the Golden Rule"; or other instances of exemplary work within the profession.
- The winner will receive an engraved trophy and a press release, be recognized at the Annual Conference, and be acknowledged in *The Independent* and on the OGR web site.
